Financial Commitment

Membership dues of \$120 (*subject to change*) are paid quarterly (August, November, February, and May). The dues are used to support the Club’s operating costs, events, and meals at formal meetings. National dues are an additional cost per year and are paid every August.

Time Commitment

Prospective members are required to attend 5 out of 6 meetings per quarter, including general meetings (2nd Tuesday of the month) and hands-on events (Quarterly on Saturdays) and event committee meetings (3rd Tuesday of the month, when applicable.)

Fundraising Commitment

Prospective members are required to raise a minimum of \$1,000 in cash, sponsorship or in-kind donations, in order to be inducted into the club in December. Active members are required to raise a minimum amount of \$2,000 year-round. \$1,000 of the \$2,000 is raised for our signature fundraising event, VIVA, the other half for Wine Soirée. This can be achieved by soliciting corporate sponsorships, selling event tickets, securing restaurant vendors, or acquiring in-kind donations (silent auction items, raffle items, etc.). Half of your minimum should come from cash donations/event sponsorships.
